This is the world-famous best-seller by the woman who popularized the field of thanatology as a subject for general social commentary.



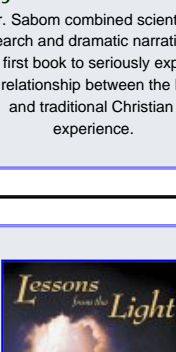
