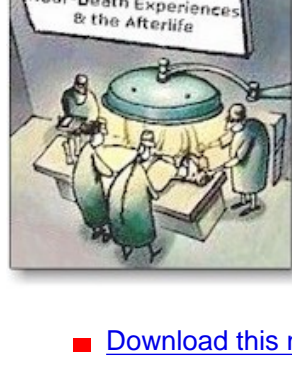

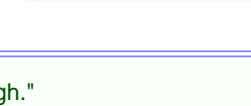
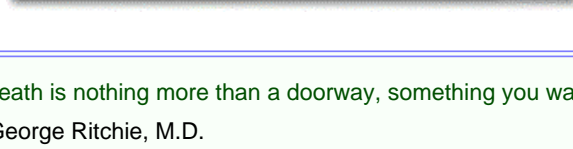

[Life After Life](#)

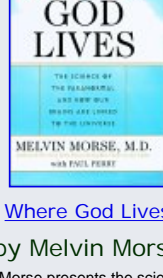
by Raymond Moody

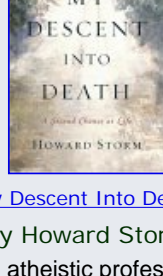

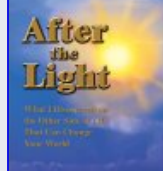
